

GIFTS THAT KEEP ON GIVING

Since Cyclone Pam hit Vanuatu in March 2015, the Liberty for the Nations 'Life Changer Permanent Shelter Project' has been replacing destroyed homes in remote villages with safe, permanent housing. Jon Blake, who is managing the project, consulted with relief agencies and remote communities immediately after the cyclone and created a very economical and sturdy little home design with a simple process of pre-fabrication and assembly. Local building teams trained specifically to prepare and build these homes will have constructed over 200 of them by September 2016, in the islands Tanna and Efate. As many houses as possible will have new water tanks. For most families, the small houses will be the first secure, cyclone-safe homes they have ever owned. All of this has been made possible by the generous donations of Australian friends and partnering groups. The houses are built for just \$2,000 each, including all transportation costs from Australia to their destination.

The local Liberty for the Nations (Liberty People) team in Vanuatu continues to do an amazing job serving communities in many other ways as well, since the devastating cyclone. In addition to the small houses, more than 44 kilometres of roof iron sheets (1,070 roof kits), hundreds of thousands of meals, bags of blankets, linen and clothing sent in shipping containers from Australia have been distributed. The disaster has been an ongoing opportunity to shine Christ's love! God always has a REDEMPTIVE plan (2 Corinthians 5:17-21). Just as God was (in Jesus) redeeming and reconciling the world to Himself, He has now GIVEN TO US the ministry of reconciling this world to Him. This is at the heart of the work.
